This year SIFEDH partnered with Folsom Lake High School to host a 3-day workshop on three consecutive Wednesdays with the girls on campus. February also happens to be career month for Folsom Lake High School which is a continuation high school in the Folsom Cordova Unified School District. Fourteen girls ranging from grade 10 to grade 12 attended the program. The first day of the program (February 5) included creating vision boards with the girls (pictured below).



Guest speakers Jana Reyes, Realtor with Keller Williams, and Gina Richardson with SAFE Credit Union spoke with the girls on the second day of the program (February 12). Guest speakers Ashley Smith, Project Engineer with Peterson Brustad Inc. and Karyss Bollen, owner of My Trendy Trailer, spoke with the girls on the final day (February 19). The speakers discussed overcoming obstacles in their lives and shared their story about the road to their careers.
